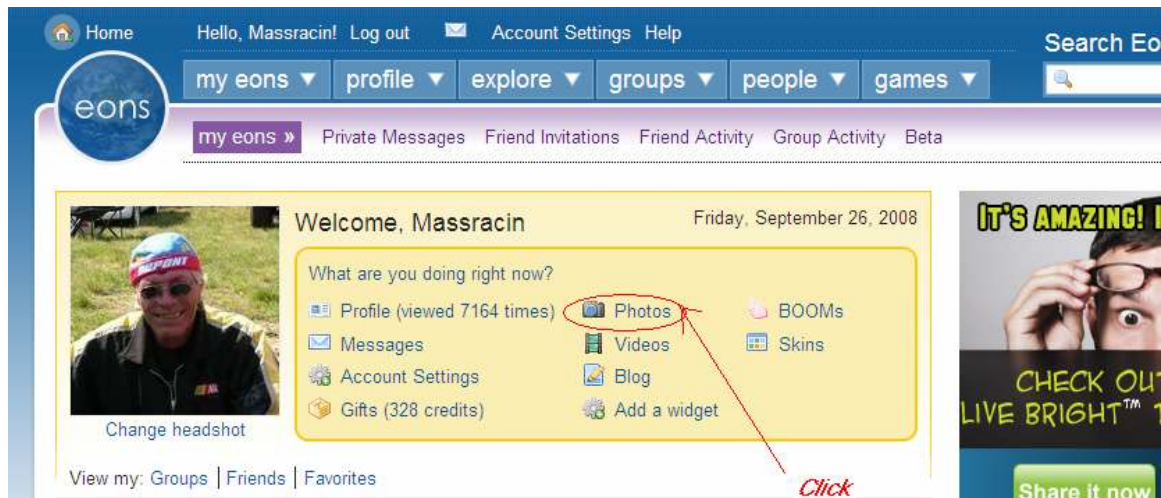


Using Photos on Eons

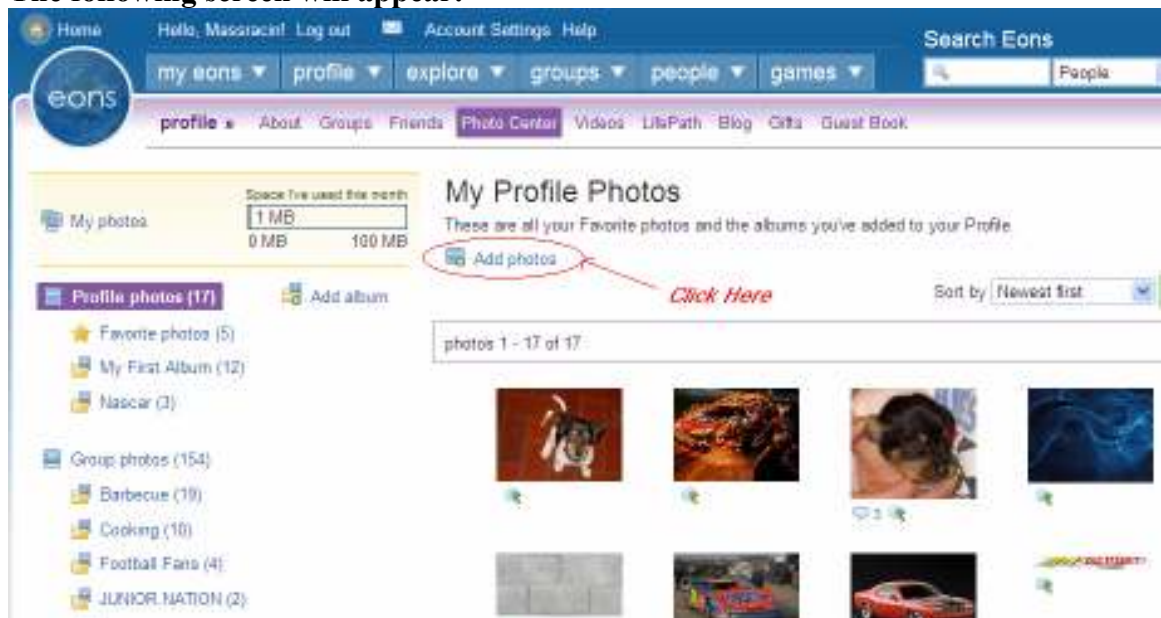
These instructions assume that you have the photos you wish to use, stored on your PC already. It is useful to organize your photos on your pc and to know where you have stored them. Note: This was done with XP and FireFox.

This will cover using Eons directly. *Please read the content of the screen shots as well.*

To start login to your Eons account and go to you're my Eons page, seen in the view below. Click on the Photos icon.

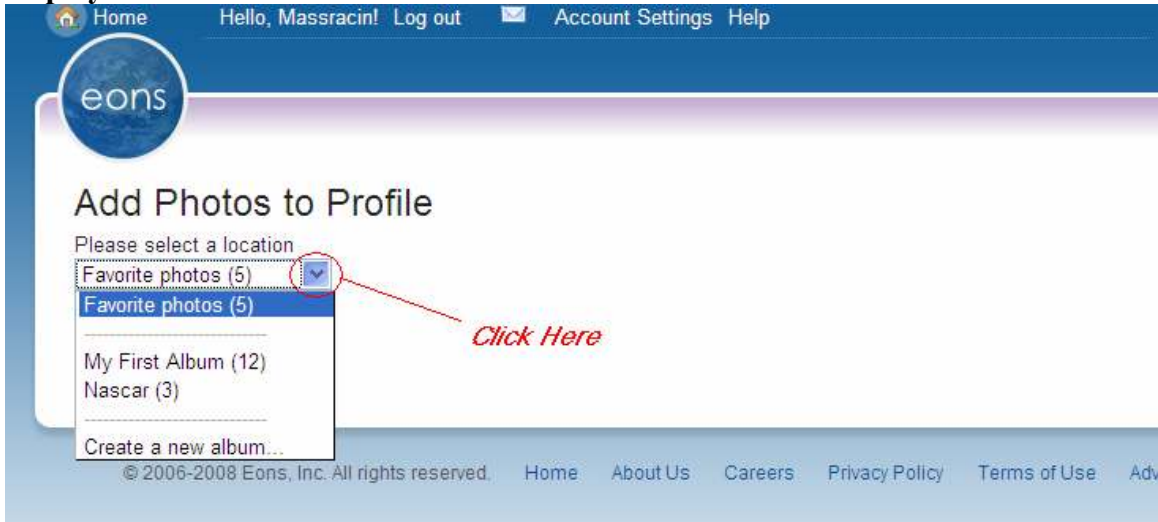


The following screen will appear:



This is the Photo Center page. All the photos that you upload to Eons are displayed here. Favorite photos are displayed on your profile. Any albums that you create are also listed. Any photos that you have uploaded to your groups are listed below your profile photos.

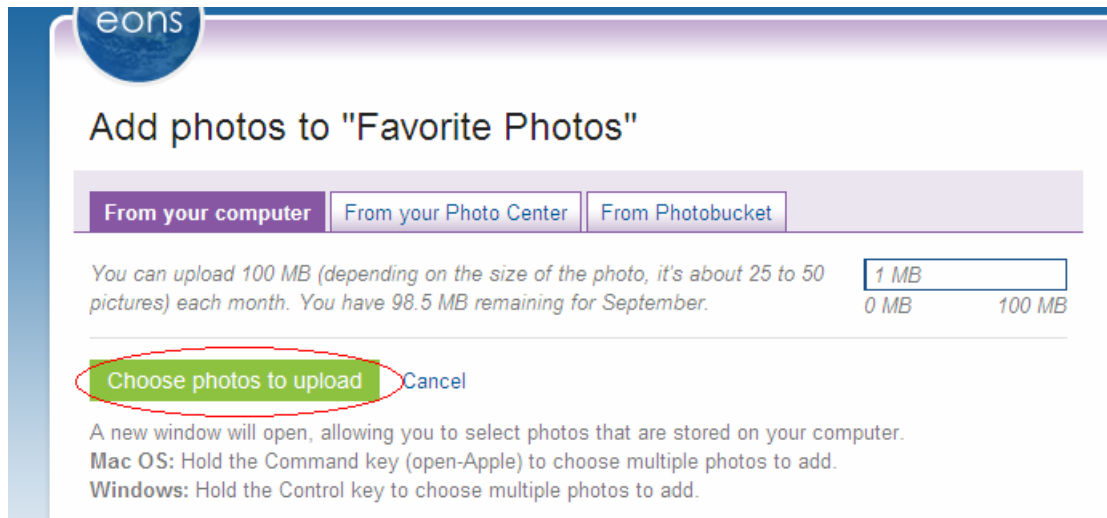
To add new photos click on the Add Photos button. The following screen will be displayed.



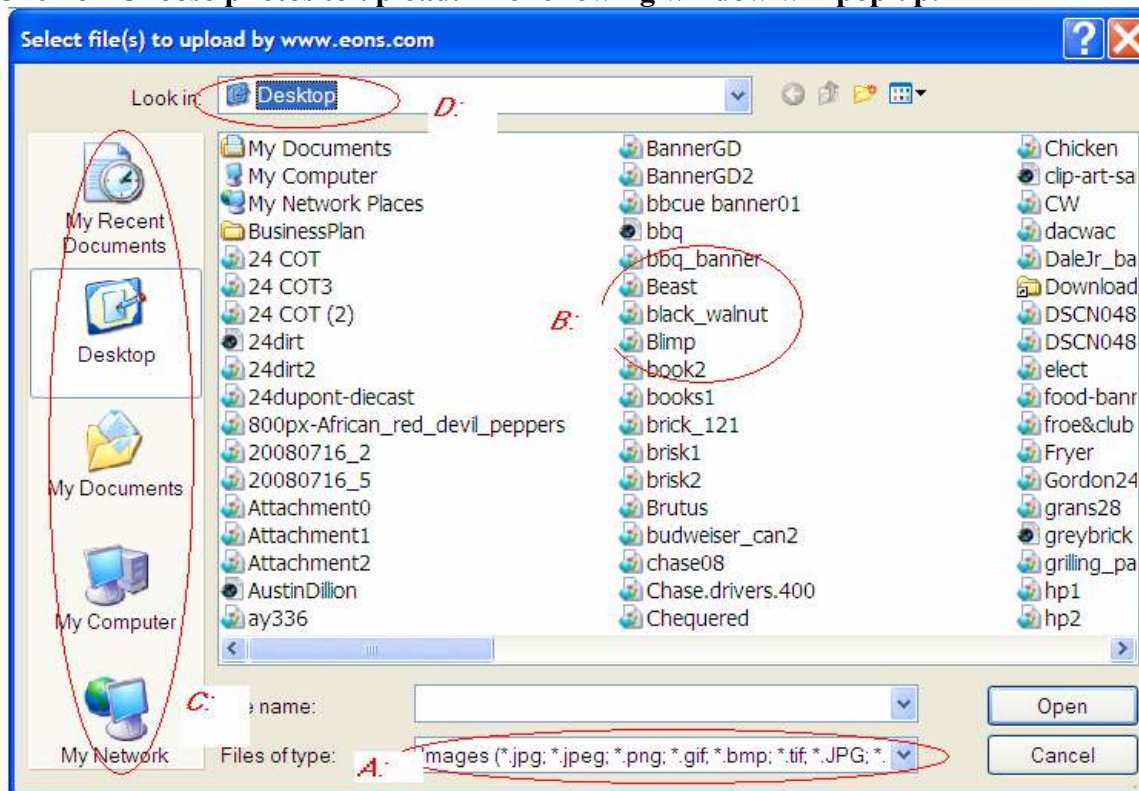
Click on the arrow to see a selection of your available albums or to create a new album. Make a selection and click continue.



The following screen will be displayed. This is where you will locate the photos that you wish to upload to Eons. Notice that the default is from your computer.



Click on Choose photos to upload. The following window will pop up.



This is where you find and select the photos you want to upload.

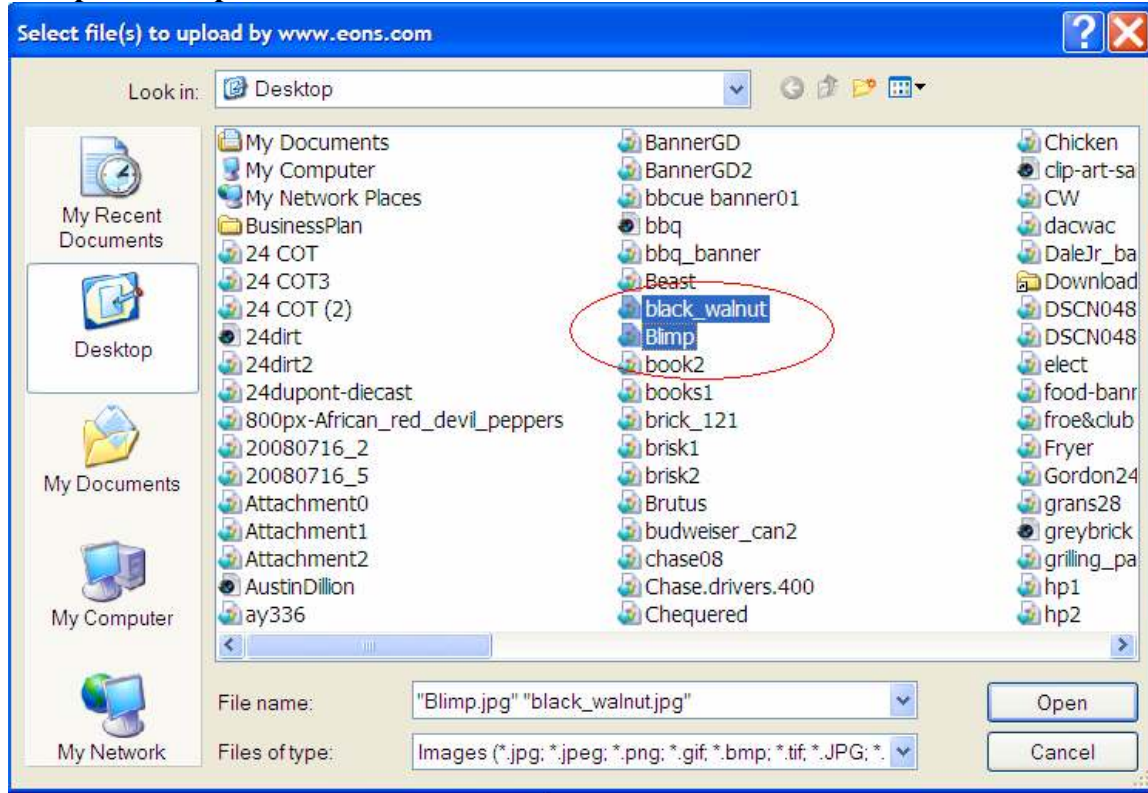
A: default photo file types that windows will display

B: the actual file names of your photos

C: quick access to main locations on your pc

D: a dropdown menu to locate photos in other folders

In this example I have selected two photos to upload to Eons, black_walnut and Blimp. Click Open to continue.

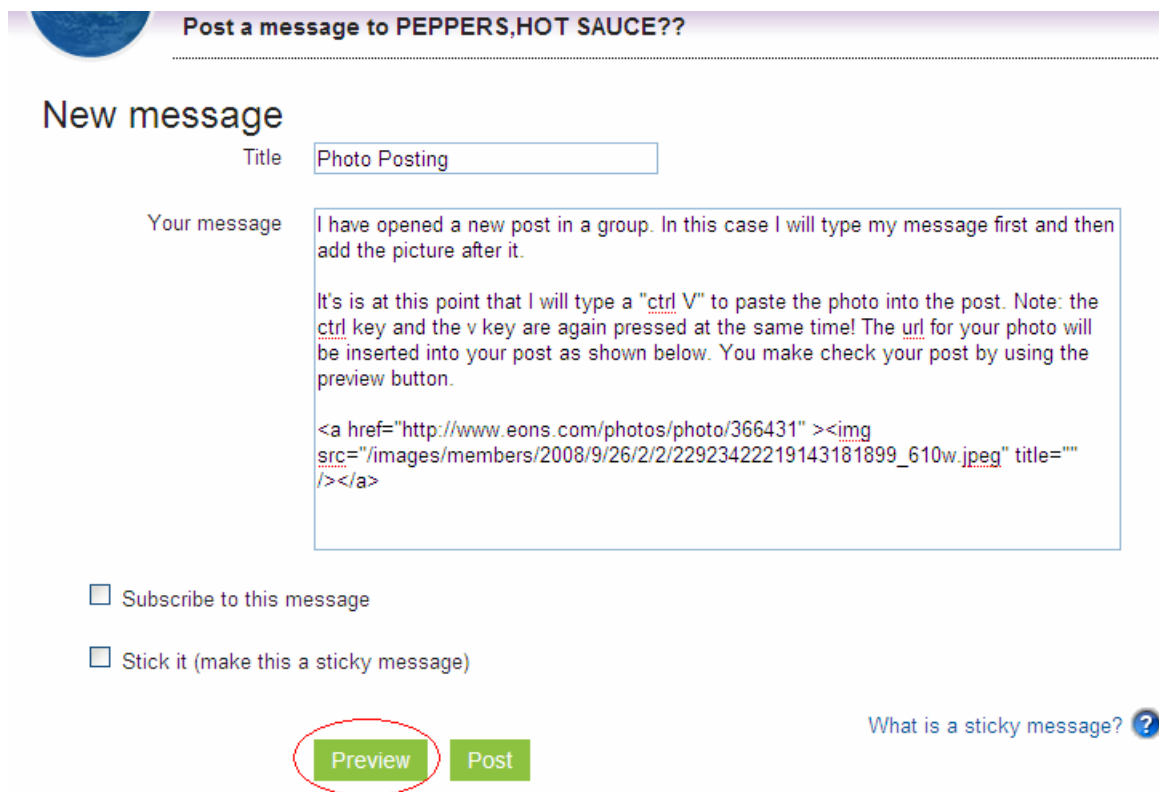
  

To use an image in a group posting on Eons simply click on the picture that you wish to use. The following screen will be displayed.



Clicking on the embed code will select it by highlighting it. You must now type "ctrl c" to copy the code. Note: the ctrl key and the c key are pressed at the same time.

Now we'll go create a new group post and add the Blimp picture to it!



This is how the post will look in preview mode and when posted. Easy eh! Simply hit post message and you are done! Congratulations!

Photo Posting

I have opened a new post in a group. In this case I will type my message first and then add the picture after it.

It's is at this point that I will type a "ctrl V" to paste the photo into the post. Note: the ctrl key and the v key are again pressed at the same time! The url for your photo will be inserted into your post as shown below. You make check your post by using the preview button.
